Hamble Community Library and Hub

We wish to advise you that Hampshire Environmental Services has been appointed by Eastleigh Borough Council to carry out the demolition of the old Barclays Bank (St Andrews Buildings), High Street, Hamble.

The site will be redeveloped to create a volunteer led community library and hub with two small, self-contained, income generating residential units above. The community space has been designed to offer flexible use by the community.

The site manager is Kevin Bell and he will be responsible for any on-site issues that may arise throughout the demolition of the building. He can be contacted on **02380 011761**. The site will be kept tidy with materials and debris being stored within the site boundary and measures will be put in place to control noise, dirt and dust.

The demolition is expected to start week commencing **Monday 07/08/2017** and finish in week commencing **Monday 04/09/2017**. The daily working hours on site will be between 8am- 6pm Monday to Friday.

We anticipate that construction of the new community library will start in early September and is due to complete in spring 2018.
